Traditional funding for artists through record labels, publishers or management.

National and local funders can support projects and career development.

Talent development programs can support you to develop and grow your music, or your music business.



APPLYING FOR FUNDING - ADVICE

Success often depends on timing & project fit.

Competition for funds can often have a big impact.

You can have a great project but the timing doesn't work, or the objectives don't align with a funders priorities.

If you have a plan – you should be able to adapt it to different applications.



Very involved application form.

Always open, 8 week turnaround for under £30k, over £30k is 12 weeks.

Worth considering the right "time" to apply if for a commercial artist

Arts Council England – Developing Your Creative Practice

For developing your art / creative work

About developing new work, not just "realisation" of a project

Set deadlines throughout the year unlike Project Grants. Next round opens 6th September.

Upto £10k.

Wide range of successful local artists. Timing is crucial.
